QUESTION	ANSWER
Q1. Did any member of the household operate an agricultural area during the period July 2002 to June 2003?	YES, ask Q2 NO, end interview
Q2. Was the aggregate area operated at least 1,000 square meters?	YES, ask Q3 NO, ask Q4
Q3. Did this household harvest any crop or had any standing crop during the period?	YES, administer questionnaire NO, ask Q4
Q4. Did this household raise livestock/poultry during the period?	YES, ask Q5 NO, ask Q6
Q5. How many (livestock/poultry) did this household raise?	Administer questionnaire if number meets criterion End interview otherwise
Q6. Was any member of this household engaged in capture fishing/aquaculture activities during the period?	YES, administer questionnaire NO, end interview
