- Confidential information revealed during the survey shall be protected pursuant to Article 33 of the Statistic Act.
- This survey covers the "Ri" administrative units set up within Eup/Myeon in accordance with the Si/Gun ordinances as of December 1, 2015.
- The rural community questionnaire surveys the basic profile, living facilities, agriculture, forestry & fisheries-related facilities, computerization, and producer organizations of Ri. It shall be filled out by the head of the Ri on behalf of his/her community.
- Answers should be based on the status as of Dec. 1, 2015. Distance and the time required to major facilities should be entered based on the following:
 - Distance: Based on the most populated "Ban" within the jurisdiction of this Ri
 - Time required: Based on travel time via vehicles owned by individuals (passenger cars, vans, etc.)

1 Location of Eup (Myeon) office
